## What Is A Neighbourhood Plan And Why Should We Have One?

How do you want your village to look in years to come? Do you want it to change, develop and grow, and to give employment, housing, education and leisure facilities? Do you want us to preserve the look and feel of the parish, and protect its local fauna and flora? Do you want to have a voice in local decision making?

Under new legislation, we have the opportunity to influence the future of our area through adoption of a Neighbourhood Plan. For instance, the development of new housing is inevitable. The Local Authority foresee a need for around 100 dwellings in the next 15 years. As a community we can influence the location and nature of such housing. But a Neighbourhood Plan drawn up

properly can influence so much more than just future housing, which is why we have formed a Strategic Policy Panel.

With your help and involvement we can put together a plan that covers

- Housing Development
- Industry Commerce & Agriculture
- Environment & Transport
- Community, Education & Leisure
