Please find attached a survey to help record wild flowers and wildlife in churchyard and cemeteries. These are often rich in wild flowers but have not been recorded since 1984 when the Women's Institutes ran a nationwide survey.

Speed Awareness Group

The Parish Council receive regular complaints regarding speeding motorists around the parish.

There are currently 4 speed awareness trained volunteers but they are desperately looking for new recruits.

To run a session there must be 3 people in attendance at any one time - one to operate the speed gun, one to note the data and one to ensure health and safety is adhered to. Training is not required for the data entry or the health and safety volunteers.
