Plant a Tree Charter Legacy Tree

In celebration of the launch of the new Tree Charter on 6 November 2017, 800 Legacy Trees will be planted across the UK. Legacy Trees will be accompanied by a small plaque about the Tree Charter. It is hoped that these trees will ensure the principles of the Tree Charter are continued well beyond 2017.

A portion of Legacy Trees have been reserved for local councils who contribute to the Tree Charter by becoming local council Charter Branches. Salford Priors Parish Council has signed up to become a local council Charter Branch.

We have received a signature gathering book detailing the 10 principles of the Tree Charter and we are being asked to collect signatures of support for these principles:

1. Thriving habitats for diverse species
2. Planting for the future
3. Celebrating the cultural impact of trees
4. A thriving forestry sector that delivers for the UK
5. Better protection for important trees and woods
6. Enhancing new developments with trees
7. Understanding and using the natural health benefits of trees
8. Access to trees for everyone
9. Addressing threats to woods and trees through good management
10. Strengthening landscapes with woods and trees

For every signature of support received, a tree will be planted. All that is required is a first and last name. The signature book will be available at the Summer Fete on 24th June, and at Parish Council meetings, along with the Leaf Newspaper.
