## **Flood relief for District Towns & Parishes**

Stratford-on-Avon District Council has informed the Parish Council that they will receive a grant under the District Council's 'one-off' Flooding Grant scheme.

The District council has awarded Salford Priors £3,000.00 towards two small scale flood relief schemes put forward by the Parish Council.

Following the 2007 summer floods the District Council was given over £600,000 by central government to help pay for clear up operation and to assist in the prevention of future problems. The majority of this money was given directly to householders who had suffered flooding with another portion being earmarked for major flood relief schemes by both the Environment agency and Warwickshire County Council.

## **District Council Suspend Green Waste Collections from November**

The Parish Council are looking to engage Verdant to carry out two green waste bin collections throughout of the parish during the suspension period.

One collection in early December and again mid February.

Unfortunately due to the size and nature of the Parish it would not be practicable to set up a civic amenity site that would benefit all of the residents of the seven settlements that form the Parish.

During this period a lot of rural gardeners prune shrubs, trees, empty containers and therefore create quite bulky waste, most houses have two or one & half green bins some have more.

## Scouts fireworks

The Clerk reported that the Scouts had requested the use of the Playing Field for a fireworks display on 4<sup>th</sup>. November.

Council agreed to the request subject to the display finishing by 9.30pm, the area roped off, neighbours being informed, and the appropriate insurance being in place.

## Playing Field Car Park Fencing

The Clerk reported that funding of £1000 had been awarded by WCC under the Public Realm Grant Scheme.

Members were reminded that an estimate of £1484 had been provided by Roger Frogley & Sons Fencing in May for a fence to WCC Education Department standards.

Cllr. James proposed, Cllr. Wolfe seconded, and it was agreed, that this estimate should be accepted.
