**Precept for 2010/11**

**The Precept for the next financial year is £47000. This is the money the Parish Council needs to spend to carry out its responsibilities to all residents. Services provided from the Precept include Amenity Mowing, Verge Mowing, Maintenance of the Playing Field and Allotments, Providing Flower Planters and Displays, Maintenance and Servicing of TOPs and the Parish Office, Providing Street Lighting, and providing the link between residents and the District and County Councils.**

**This year there has been an increase in the Precept of £6000 and although this is a large increase it follows a reduction the previous year when several grants were obtained. However, the average increase since 2005/06 has been 3.5 per cent. This year we have potential major expenditure for new street lights at £1000 each and we have to provide for these. For a Band D property the Parish Precept is equivalent to £1.65 per week.**
