
What's the scheme about?

Warwickshire Rural Community Council (WRCC) runs an oil syndicate that reduces the cost of domestic heating oil.

All you need to do to take advantage of the Warwickshire Community Oil Syndicate is pay an annual membership fee, which will cover as many oil orders as you need during the course of the year.

What's the snag?

There isn't one. The scheme is being promoted by Warwickshire Rural Community Council, a long established and well respected charity.



By bringing communities throughout Warwickshire together and making the most of joint buying power we can make savings and pass them directly to people like you whose fuel costs are high simply because you use oil-fired central heating. Members

make a saving of approximately £50 per 1000 litres against the average market price.

The environment benefits too

Every time a tanker comes out to make a delivery it is using a lot of diesel – a full tanker can get as little as 8 miles per gallon. If deliveries are organised so that one tanker delivers to several customers in a village instead of making lots of individual deliveries fuel consumption is reduced and so is traffic in the village.

This fee covers your oil deliveries for one year.

Domestic: £20 ★ Community Building: £30 ★ Business: £100

5 easy steps to cheaper heating oil

Step 1: Join the WRCC Scheme

Request a membership form from WRCC via email or telephone, or apply via our website at www.ruralwarwickshire.org.uk/oil.

Step 2: We will be in touch

We will acknowledge your membership application and provide an order form. Some areas have a Local Co-ordinator who collects local monthly orders and, if there is one in your area, we will let them know that you have joined. We act as the Co-ordinator in communities where there isn't one.

Step 3: Place an order

Let us, or your Local Co-ordinator, know you want to buy oil. Your order increases our negotiating power so once submitted we regard it as binding. The minimum order is 500 litres.

Step 4: Sit back whilst the price is negotiated

The best price is negotiated from a range of local suppliers. You will be advised of the price per litre (exclusive of VAT, currently at 5%), supplier, payment and delivery details.

Step 5: Take delivery and pay the supplier

The oil will be delivered as soon as possible and you pay the company supplying the oil direct.

There is currently no Local Co-ordinator within your area so we will act as your co-ordinator.

Next order deadlines are midday on:

Thursday 31st October 2013 (November delivery)

Thursday 21st November 2013 (December delivery)

Thursday 2nd January 2014 (January delivery)

Our August delivery saved members just over £58.00 per 1000 litres against the average market price.
